



The potential blood donor contribution from men who have sex with men (MSM)*



4.5% of men estimated to be MSM

- 3% gay/bi^{2,4,5,6}
- 1.5% men who mainly identify as heterosexual³

Based on 4.5% of male donor age (18-75) population¹

Less 21,468 MSM living with HIV⁷

This excludes trans women and some nonbinary people who have sex with men**

3.5% Australians donate blood⁸


13,542 MSM potential donors

* Men who have sex with men (MSM), as well transgender women and some nonbinary people who have sex with men, need to abstain from having sex with a male for 3 months (even with a long-term partner) in order to donate.
** Population data on trans women and nonbinary people who have sex with men is not currently available.
